SAT 28 **DEPART LOS ANGELES**

Please check-in at the Air New Zealand International Terminal at least 2 hours before your departure time.

8:45 pm Depart Los Angeles on NZ 53 (STOPOVER IN Papeete, French Polynesia)

SUN 29 **ARRIVE RAROTONGA, COOK ISLANDS**

7:05 am Arrive Rarotonga. After going through customs and immigration, you will be met and transferred to your hotel, where you have early check in. You can get some New Zealand currency via the ATM at the airport - you should withdraw enough for the next two days. You can, of course, get cash at the hotel but the rate will not be nearly as favourable.

Church services in the Cook Islands are known for the congregational singing, and since you are both church musicians I think you will find it very interesting to attend! Take the island bus to the Cook Islands Christian church (Ziona Tapu Church) that is closest to town. The bus can return you to the hotel after the services. Please wear a hat and proper church attire

This afternoon, the tour of the Takitumu Conservation for bird watching has been arranged for you. Please pay the guide directly: this is not included in the package with EDUT.

MON 01 **DEPART RAROTONGA**

(B) TROPICAL BREAKFAST INCLUDED

TRANSFER BACK TO AIRPORT: time to be arranged with the hotel.

8:20 am Depart Rarotonga on NZ 53. Cross international date line.

TUE 02 **WELCOME TO NEW ZEALAND**

11.40 am Arrive Auckland International Airport Air New Zealand flight NZ53. After completing entry formalities depart Customs and enter the Main Arrivals Hall where you will be met by our New Zealand staff, who will provide you with the final documents and vouchers for your New Zealand tour. He will be standing at the 'Meeting Point' behind the seating area with a

signboard displaying your name. Transfer by Supershuttle to the hotel, which is located in the downtown area and within walking distance of the waterfront. Normal check in time applies. Afternoon at leisure to explore independently.

WED 03 **AUCKLAND/ROTORUA**

(D)

9.30 am You will be met at the hotel by Budget Rental Cars Staff. Collect a Mitsubishi Lancer or similar 1.6 litre automatic vehicle and drive south over the Bombay Hills through the fertile farmlands of the Waikato Valley then across the bush-clad Mamaku Ranges to the thermal wonderland of Rotorua. Visit the Maori Arts and Crafts Institute where young Maori are taught the carving and weaving skills of their ancestors as well as the Whakarewarewa Thermal Reserve – home to the Pohutu Geyser, boiling mud pools and other thermal activity (guided tours depart on the hour or self guide maps are available).

6.30-6.45pm Transfer from the hotel by Tamaki Tours coach to a marae (pre-European village) for the powhiri (welcome), wero (challenge by the warrior), hangi (dinner cooked in the traditional earth oven over hot stones) and concert of Maori song and dance including the vigorous haka. Jacket/sweater may be required as the first part of the evening takes place outdoors. Dinner served approx 8.45pm and you will be returned to Rotorua approx 10.30pm. The hotel is centrally located near the lovely Government Gardens and has an historic charm and atmosphere.

This morning drive south (approx 30 minute) to the colourful Wai-O-Tapu Thermal Park where the Lady Knox geyser plays at 10.15am every day (with a little help). Enjoy a walk around the park to see the mineral deposits in the Artists Palette, the bubbling Champagne Pool and the silica terraces. Remainder of the day at leisure to explore independently.

This afternoon drive to your farmstay – your hosts will be expecting you from 3.00pm onwards. This property is a 20 hectare sheep farm in the Paradise Valley area – enjoy a tour of the property and then share dinner with your hosts in the evening.

Drive through the city and around the shores of the lake to the Rotorua Airport.

Return rental vehicle to the Rental Car carpark and deliver keys to the Budget Rental Cars counter in the terminal building.

12:20 PM Depart Rotorua on NZ 5377

2:05 pm Arrive Christchurch. Transfer by Supershuttle to your accommodation, which is located within walking distance of Cathedral Square. Remainder of the day is free to enjoy the 'Garden City' – you may wish to wander through the Botanic Gardens which are open until 8.00pm.

SAT 06 **AKAROA EXCURSION**

(B) Breakfast at the guesthouse.

Make your own way to the InterCity depot, 123 Worcester St.

8.30 am Report for InterCity coach service IC8609 (operated by French Connections).

8.45 am Depart Christchurch.

10.30 am Arrive Akaroa. There is a time to enjoy a stroll along the streets of this settlement, which was originally settled by the French.

11.30 am Report to the Dolphin Watch Office, Main Wharf (Blue Building). Bring warm jacket/sweater, sunhat and sunscreen.

12.00 pm Enjoy a Dolphin Watch cruise on the Akaroa Harbour – the Hector Dolphins that inhabit these waters are the smallest species in the world.

3.00 pm Return to Akaroa Wharf. Time at leisure to enjoy the village.

4.00 pm Report for InterCity coach service IC8608 (operated by French Connections).

4.15 pm Depart Akaroa.

5.45 pm Arrive Christchurch. Make your own way back to your accommodation.

SUN 07 **CHRISTCHURCH/FRANZ JOSEF**

(B) Breakfast at the guesthouse.

7.25 am Transfer by Supershuttle from the guesthouse to the Christchurch Railway Station.

7.55 am Report for the Tranz Alpine train. Seat no.s to be advised on departure.

8.15 am Depart Christchurch on the Tranz Alpine train for a rail journey through the splendour of the Southern Alps to the West Coast.

12.45 pm Arrive Greymouth. Report to the Budget counter in the Station Building and collect a Mitsubishi Lancer or similar 1.6 litre rental vehicle. Travel down the western coastline through the town of Hokitika where you may wish to visit one of the Greenstone studios where this local jade is crafted into jewellery and ornaments of both traditional and modern design. Continue on to the village of Franz Josef. The hotel is in the village centre.

MON 08 **FRANZ JOSEF/WANAKA**

This morning you may wish to view the glacier – it is approx 55 minutes walk from the carpark area to the terminal face (guided walks available at extra cost) or perhaps take a scenic flight over the glacier area with a snow landing for that special photo opportunity (not included). Drive through Fox Glacier where, time permitting, you may wish to walk around the shores of Lake Matheson, well known for the near perfect reflections of the mountains in its still waters, then through the ever-changing scenery of rainforest, streams, wild beaches and the rugged beauty of the Haast Pass to the delightful lakeside resort of Wanaka. The hotel is situated on the lake edge and is a short drive from town.

TUE 09 **WANAKA/QUEENSTOWN**

Morning free to enjoy the area.

12.45 pm Report to the Tour XXX Office at the Log Cabin on the lakefront.

1.00 pm Cruise across the lake by boat to Stevenson’s Island for a short guided tour. The Buff Weka (a native bird) has recently been released onto the island and have now made themselves at home.

3.00 pm Tour concludes. Travel across the fruit-growing area of Central Otago or alternatively over the Crown Range and into Queenstown which is located on the shores of Lake Wakatipu. The hotel is located a short walk downhill from the town centre.

ACCOMMODATION: XXXX LAKEFRONT HOTEL (1 NIGHT)

WED 10 **QUEENSTOWN/TE ANAU/MILFORD SOUND**

(D) This morning drive around the shores of Lake Wakatipu then across rolling countryside to Te Anau, the gateway to the Fiordland National Park (approx 2 hour).

12.10 pm Report to the XXX Tour Office at the Lakefront.

12.30 pm Depart Te Anau by coach and travel through the dramatic landscape of the National Park to Milford Sound.

5.00 pm Board the Milford XXXX and cruise the fiord enjoying the stunning scenery of cascading waterfalls, rainforest and sheer cliff faces. There is the opportunity to explore the shoreline independently by kayak or with the nature guide in the tender boat. Dinner is served aboard as the boat anchors in a sheltered bay of the overnight stay. Twin ensuite cabins.

THU 11 **MILFORD SOUND/TE ANAU/STEWART ISLAND**

(BD) Breakfast on board then the boat return to Milford Wharf approx 9.15am. Travel by coach to Te Anau arriving 12.30pm then collect the rental vehicle and drive through the picturesque countryside of Southland to Invercargill, the world's most southern city.

12.00 pm Return rental vehicle to the Budget carpark at the Invercargill Airport and return the keys to the Budget Counter in the terminal building.

12.30 pm Check in for the Stewart Island flight. Luggage limit 15kgs – extra luggage can be stored at the Stewart Island Flights Office.

1.00 pm Depart Invercargill

1.20 pm Arrive Stewart Island. You will be met by XXXX Lodge courtesy vehicle and transferred to the lodge. Remainder of the afternoon at leisure. Please contact XXXX to reconfirm your Ulva Island arrangements and XXXXX to reconfirm date and time of departure for your Kiwi Spotting Excursion. Dinner at the lodge this evening.

ACCOMMODATION: XXXX LODGE (3 NIGHTS)

FRI 12 **STEWART ISLAND**

(BD) After breakfast at the lodge the day is at leisure to enjoy this little piece of paradise. The island has a wonderful native bird population and there are some scenic walks through native bush and along the coastline. There are kayaks and water taxis for hire or you may wish to enjoy a round of golf on the world's most southern golf course (not included). Dinner at the lodge this evening then as night falls join a kiwi spotting tour. Travel by boat and uphill walk to a remote beach (by torchlight) where you may see these creatures foraging for insects among the seaweed on the shoreline (good level of fitness required). Comfortable walking shoes/boots, warm jacket/sweater recommended and bring your own flashlight if possible.

SAT 13 **STEWART ISLAND**

(BD) Breakfast at the lodge.

8.15 am Report to Golden Bay Wharf. Bring jacket/sweater, sunhat and sunscreen and wear comfortable walking shoes/boots.

8.20 am Depart the wharf and cruise across to Ulva Island. Enjoy a half day guided tour of this picturesque forested island, which is predator free and has become an open sanctuary. There are recently released rare South Island saddlebacks and the threatened South Island Robin as well as tui, bellbird, fantail, kaka, weak and parakeet. Reasonable level of fitness is required – 4 hours of walking.

Afternoon at leisure before dinner at the lodge this evening.

SUN 14 **STEWART ISLAND/CHRISTCHURCH**

(B) Breakfast at the lodge then the day is free. Normal checkout time applies. Transfer to Stewart Island airstrip by XXXX Lodge vehicle (please confirm departure time with your hosts).

3:50pm Report for Stewart Island Flight.

4.30 am Depart Stewart Island.

4.50 am Arrive Invercargill airport

6:45 pm check in for Air NZ 5086

7:15 pm Depart Invercargill

8:25 pm Arrive Christchurch. Contact the hotel on the courtesy Freephone and transfer by shuttle to the hotel, which is a short walk from the Airport terminal and the interesting International Antarctic Centre where you can see what life is like on the frozen continent (not included).

Transfer to the Christchurch airport by hotel courtesy shuttle (please arrange time with hotel reception). Please check-in at the international terminal at least 2 hours before departure and pay the NZ\$25.00 per person Airport Departure Tax at the BNZ Bank.

7:00 am Depart Christchurch on NZ 181

ARRIVE ADELAIDE/SELF DRIVE TO WARRAWONG EARTH SANCTUARY – (self drive)

8:30 am Arrive Sydney. You will have to go through customs and immigration in upon arrival in Australia, it may be in Sydney or you may be transferred to your connecting flight and do customs when you land in Adelaide.

10:25 am QF 747 departs Sydney.

12:05 pm Upon arrival into Adelaide on board Qantas Airways flight QF 747, please make your way through customs and immigrations into the arrivals hall. Here you will be met and welcomed by your local Essential Downunder Travel representative who will hand over your touring documentation and accompany you with the collection of your (automatic) rental vehicle for self drive to the hotel.

Please Note Important Information:

- Please look for your Essential Downunder Travel representative once you exit customs. The representative will be holding a placard with your names on it.
- Due to your early arrival your room may not be ready for immediate occupancy.

Some time this afternoon self drive Warrawong Earth Sanctuary this afternoon (25 minute drive from Adelaide).

Directions to Warrawong:

Follow the South Eastern Freeway. Take the Stirling exit which is well sign posted, turn right at the roundabout. Follow Avenue Road, which becomes Longwood Road for approximately five kilometres, turn left at the Warrawong sign onto Stock Road. The main entrance for Warrawong Earth Sanctuary is 300 metres on your left.

In 1969, Doctor John Wamsley bought Warrawong, a 35 acre dairy farm devoid of any native vegetation. Wishing to repair the damage done by 100 years of intensive farming and keen to attract native animals, he embarked on an extensive re-vegetation program. By 1980 over 50,000 native plants had been established but native birds, attracted back by the maturing vegetation fell prey to cats and foxes. In 1982, believing it was not possible to have a balance between native and introduced species, Doctor Wamsley designed and built the vermin proof fence that surrounds Warrawong. This was the first vermin free area on mainland Australia. Once the fence was completed, the bird populations flourished and the re-establishment and releasing of mammal species began. Since 1985, Rufous Bettongs, Long-nosed Potoroos, Woylies, Southern Brown Bandicoots, Bilbies and Tammar Wallabies have been reintroduced to the wild sanctuary and are thriving. In 1988, Platypus were introduced to Blackwater Lake and three years later the first captive births for 50 years were recorded. Today, Warrawong is also home to a highly successful breeding program for Eastern Quoll.

7:00 pm A NOCTURNAL WALK is included in your visit - Depart around sunset to see and experience Australia's famous wildlife such as bilbies, koalas, bettongs and bandicoots in their natural habitat. Self drive to Adelaide.

(L,D) Self drive to the Adelaide Airport (main terminal) and return the rental vehicle to the Hertz counter. Own transfer arrangements to the Adelaide General Aviation Terminal (approx 5 minutes in a taxi – own expense) for flight to Kangaroo Island.

08:45 am Check in with the airline for departure flight to Kangaroo Island.

09:15 am Depart on board Emu Airways flight 245 to Kangaroo Island.

09:45 am Upon arrival into Kingscote Airport you will be met by your XXX Tour representative. Then, off to Seal Bay Conservation Park. Learn how the Australian sea-lion survives the rigours of the Southern Ocean. The colony of bulls, cows and pups rests on the beach where you can walk amongst them. A visit to the spectacular and vast sand dunes of Little Sahara. From the South Coast we traverse the rural areas of the middle of the Island via the Parndana Wildlife Park. North Coast beaches, Snellings and Stokes are perfect for a leisurely stroll to enjoy the sound of waves breaking on the pristine, sandy coast. Nature walk through the drooping she-oaks of Latham National Park and observe the kangaroos and wallabies. This is also the habitat of the rare Glossy Black Cockatoo, and great country for the elusive echidna (spiny ant-eater) The first day's touring concludes with your return to your Island accommodation.

WED 17 **KANGAROO ISLAND TOURING**
(B,L,D) Pick up from accommodation for transfer to Rocky River, headquarters of the Flinders Chase National Park. Here, kangaroos laze and Cape Barren geese graze. The Chase is home to all our varieties of native animals and birds. On to Admirals Arch, an ancient limestone formation close to the ocean, a perfect haul-out area for an active colony of the New Zealand fur seal. To Remarkable Rocks, via the spectacular coastline of Cape du Couedic, where the forces of nature have carved modern sculptures out of the granite. A short bush walk searching for the Echidna (spiny ant-eater) and observing the colourful Kangaroo Island endemic Crimson Rosella. Vivonne Bay, its crystal clear water, supports a colony of the Little Penguin. Your guide takes you to Point Ellen where you fossick for shells on the beach and possibly sight a penguin in its rookery.

THU 18 **KANGAROO ISLAND TO ADELAIDE - (fly)/Day at leisure**
(B) Transfer to Kingscote airport for flight to Adelaide.

10:15 am Depart on board Emu Airways flight 246 to Adelaide.
